January 6, 2020 City Council Meeting Summary

A retail on-off sale malt beverage and a retail on-off sale wine license for R & D Management, LLC for El Fredo Pizza was approved. The address of the restaurant and location of the approved licenses is 831 East Cherry Street.

A proclamation declaring Monday, January 20, 2020 as Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service was read.

The payroll resolution for 2020 was approved. State statute requires the publication of a complete list of all officers and employees of the City with the first meeting following the start of the fiscal year. Elected officials and employees are receiving a 2.5% cost of living adjustment.

Brunick's Service was awarded the January fuel bid.
