JUNE 21, 2021 CITY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY:

A hearing for granting JMP, LLC a retail on-off sale malt beverage with SD Wine license for JMP, LLC for Speede Mart at 802 E. Cherry for the period of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 was continued until the July 6, 2021 City Council meeting.

The Clay County Agricultural Fair Association was granted the closing of a portion of High Street from Cherry Street to the Vermillion Public Transit driveway, alongside a special daily malt beverage and wine license for the Clay County Fair events on August 12, 13, and 14, 2021 at the Clay County Fairgrounds.

A special daily malt beverage and wine license, permit to exceed permissible sound levels, and street closings for Ribs, Rods, and Rock N' Roll were approved. This year the events take place on Friday, September 10 and Saturday, September 12, 2021 in downtown Vermillion.

Ordinance 1436 approving a cable franchise agreement with VAST Broadband was approved.

Ordinance 1437 pausing medical cannabis regulations in the Joint Jurisdictional Zoning Area was approved.

USD was granted the closings of N. Plum Street from E. Cherry Street to SD Highway 50 from 6:00 am to 4:00 pm, and Rose Street from Coyote Village north to the Dakota Dome from 5:00 am to 4:00 pm, for their student Move-In day on August 20, 2021.

Alpha Phi Sorority was granted the closing of N. Pine Street from E. Cedar Street to E. National Street on August 19, 2021 from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm for their Sorority Recruitment Bid Day.

Assignment of airport hangar lease from Mr. David Howard d/b/a Howard Aviation, LLC to Mr. Rollie T. French was approved.

A public hearing date of July 6, 2021 was set for a special permit to exceed permissible sound levels for the Vermillion Cultural Association event on July 22, 2021 on the roof of 12 E. Main Street.

City Manager's Report:

One term on the BID #1 (Business Improvement District), the Board working with the hotel/motel lodging fee is available. Per the originating ordinance, this seat is for an individual who owns or manages a lodging facility.

There is a vacancy on the Planning and Zoning Commission for a term expiring in July 2022. Expression of interest forms are due by 5 pm on Thursday, July 15, 2021. Anticipate that the City Council will make an appointment at the July 19, 2021 meeting.

City offices will be closed on Monday, July 5, 2021 to observe the July 4th holiday on Sunday. The next City Council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 6, 2021.

Fraternal Order of Eagles is selling raffle tickets at \$20 each or 6 for \$100. The drawing will be on June 11, 2022. The prize is a 2021 Can-Am Maverick X3 DS Turbo R 4-wheeler. Proceeds are donated to the Abbott House Foundation.
